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# Social Justice Ecosystems Supervision

The following slides provide a summary of the approach I wish to develop as a supervisor as a leader of group Supervision. This approach is already infused into working one to one as a supervisor.

- Slide 1 focuses on a model that explores the roles we tend to show up in as change agents and encourages exploration of the costs and benefits and the scope for flexing between different roles and modes of being.
- Slide 2 represents the lens I apply based on my research into coaching for social change.
- Slide 3 is the CSA curriculum in which I am being trained. Training began October 2020 and ends in September 2021 I currently have 35 hours of supervision experience and counting. I have also been a co-coaching forum facilitator for the AC for two year, running a monthly session to support coach development.

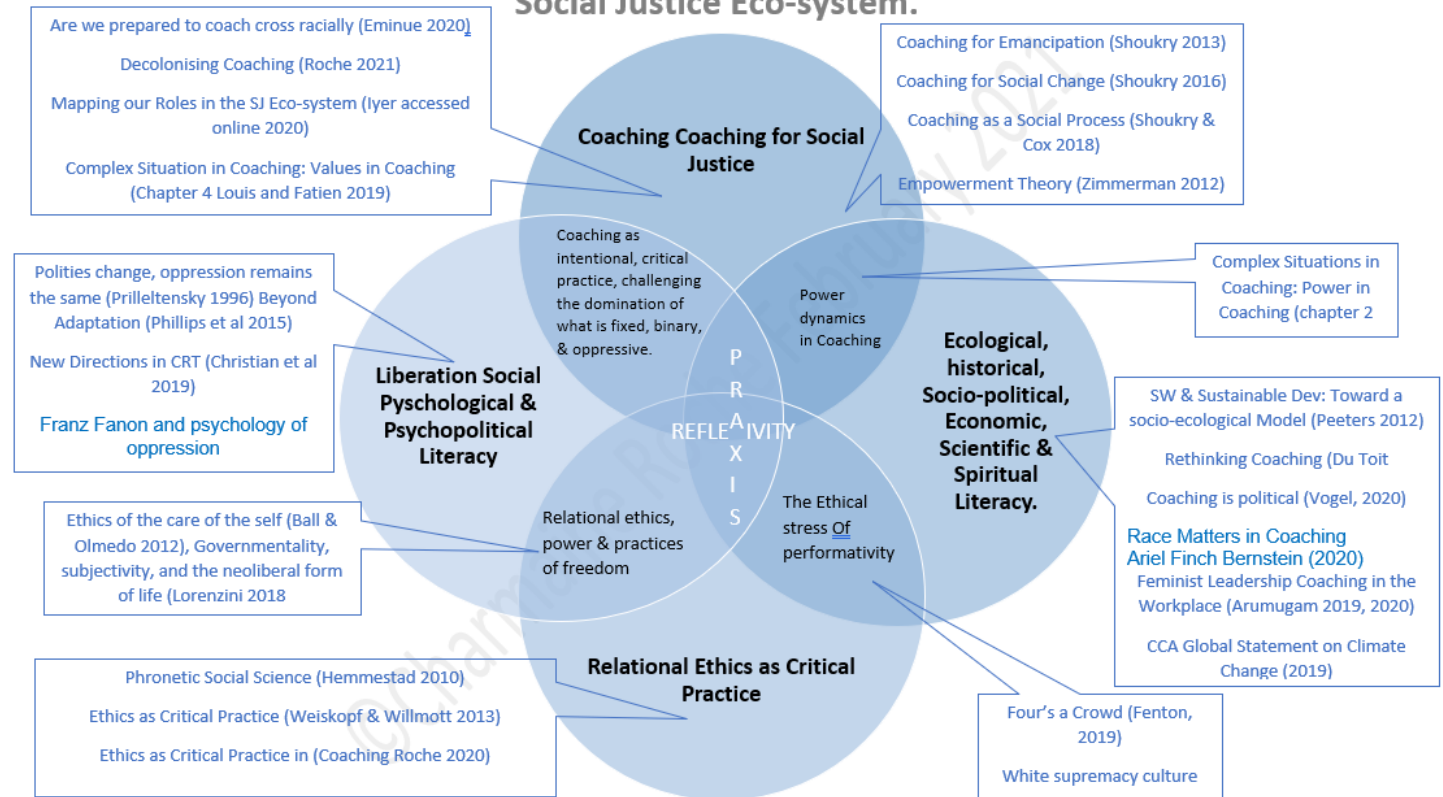

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# Underpinned by CSA Supervision Curriculum
